

SKYDIVE CITY COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOLS

Face Masks are Required at Skydive City

- Everyone at Skydive City must have a mask in their possession
- Face masks must be worn in any location where you are within six feet of another or there is a high likelihood that you could come within six feet of others.
- Face masks are required in the following areas:
 - In the boarding area
 - In the airplane
 - On Moby Deck
 - In the Birdhouse main room
 - Birdhouse packing area unless six feet distance can be maintained
 - The Bunker
 - Outside Manifest
 - In the Tandem Instruction area
- Ordinary face masks prohibited in freefall as a safety precaution – use a full-face helmet

Face Mask Consequences: One warning to educate. Second warning: two weeks hiatus from the drop zone

Manifest Procedures

- Manifest will be closed for in office transactions
- All transactions through windows, both sides wearing face masks; hand sanitizer available on customer and manifest side.
- Manifest will administer a Covid questionnaire (copy at manifest) to determine if jumper has symptoms.
- Manifest will take touchless forehead temperature of all tandem students registering.
- Manifest will take temperature of all jumpers presenting to manifest for their first jump of the day.
- Manifest will hand a flyer to tandem students that spectators accompanying them must wear face masks and the student is responsible for communicating that to their guests and helping us enforce the rules.

Boarding and Aircraft Precautions

- Loader will provide a squirt of hand sanitizer to each jumper.
- Loader should wear face mask.

Loader safety and responsibilities:

Prior to first load and between loads, loader shall use Lysol on rags to swab the aircraft interior. Prior to first load, loader will swab the metal on each seat belt, including pilot seatbelts; and, clean the bar and the sides of the door.

Loader should ensure six feet of distance between persons when loading, except tandem instructors will hold the harness of students.

Loader will not permit anyone to enter the aircraft without a face mask.

Keep 6 feet distance as boarding the airplane.

Precautionary measures in the aircraft:

The door may be opened at safe altitude to encourage air circulation.

Skydivers and students MUST wear a neck buff pulled up over mouth and nose, or other face mask, in the boarding area, in the aircraft (and on exit if exits are in tight proximity – tight exits should be avoided).

A cloth, sleeve or other barrier is recommended to fasten seat belts.

Persons working the FLIGHT LINE should NOT wear masks – they could interfere with vision. *Except* the loader should wear a face mask when dispensing hand sanitizer to skydivers.

Social Distancing

- No fist-bumping, high-fiving, handshakes, or other unnecessary touching.
- Remain six feet from all persons wherever practical
- No persons in manifest or inside buildings except open air buildings
- Manifest will operate through the window for all transactions
- Dirt Dive with virtual, distanced touching strongly encouraged

Covid Waivers & Questionnaires

Everyone will sign a covid addendum to their waiver

Everyone will answer a questionnaire regarding their relevant health and potential exposure.

- “Yes” responses must leave Skydive City.

Facilities Sanitation and Protocols and Sharing Items

No team rooms may be used. Exception: Arrange with Manifest for rooms to be cleaned thoroughly prior to use and after use.

Bathrooms – cleaned before opening and throughout the day with bleach solution.

Commonly touched spaces swabbed down with a bleach rag, including door handles.

Manifest – avoid sharing computers – unless wearing gloves or wipe down in between use.

Bleach solutions – dilute to prevent gear damage and should not be used where skydiving gear is located or likely to be located.

Other Considerations

- Florida requires quarantining for 14 days after entering Florida *from areas with 'substantial community spread,'* including New York Tri-State area and State of Louisiana.
- Treat all body fluids (such as diarrhea, vomit, or blood) like they are infectious.
- Handwashing is the single most important infection control measure.
- Wash hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds after touching potentially contaminated body fluids or surfaces.
- Use alcohol-based hand rub (containing at least 60% alcohol) if soap and water are not available.
- Avoid touching your mouth, eyes, and nose with unwashed or gloved hands.
- SKYDIVERS ARE REMINDED: Please do not be so focused on coronavirus safety that you overlook skydiving safety.
- Persons from areas of 'substantial community spread' to quarantine for 14-days after entering Florida, including Louisiana and the tri-state area (NY, CT, NJ).

Enforcement

The most important requirement is face masks. **One warning to educate, second warning results in two weeks ban from the DZ.**

Enforcement is the responsibility of everyone on the drop zone. Skydive City will assiduously *attempt* to enforce these guidelines and precautions but cannot assure that they are always implemented or properly implemented. No Amount of Care or Caution by Skydive City can assure that you do not become infected by Covid-19 at Skydive City. Do not rely on our precautions. You are here at your own risk. If you cannot accept that or do not choose to follow our protocols – leave.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- Never sacrifice aircraft and skydiving safety.
- Avoid holding items held by others. Use hand sanitizer after holding items held by others.
- Refuse to interact with people who appear ill and alert management.
- Instructors – refuse to jump with anyone who appears ill and advise management.

No Spectators

- No spectators at Skydive City unless accompanying tandem students
 - Spectators accompanying tandems must wear face masks at all locations where required.

- Everyone should *politely* inform spectators (who are not with tandems) not to be here – alert management if they do not leave

TANDEM & AFF PRECAUTIONS:

No Bleach or *any other product*, including hand sanitizer, on or near tandem gear.

Tandem Instructors – use full face helmet; wear a buff or other lower face mask or covering when speaking with and harnessing students, and require students to wear a face mask; on initial interaction with customers, escort them to the manifest bathroom to wash their hands. Full face helmets are voluntary for tandem instructors, but strongly urged.

All Instructors – wash hands prior to and after each customer interaction.

Tandem students should not use a jumpsuit.

AFF students should wear a jumpsuit – using the same jumpsuit all day.

Making videos

Videographer and Student should wear a face mask — *except* face masks of the student and videographer may be removed if filming is at a minimum six-foot distance.

MANIFEST SAFETY AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Use barrier (such as glove, paper, cloth) between hand and shared items (such as pens). Use hand sanitizer frequently and if this protocol is overlooked.

Manifest will periodically remind about face masks and , manifest will read the signs about hand washing and risks over the loudspeaker.

AFTER JUMP PROTOCOLS

Go directly home after jumping without making a stop.

Launder clothes and wash thoroughly.

SIGNAGE & BARRIERS

Sign at front gate: No Spectators

Plexiglass barrier between customers and manifest.

Plexiglass barrier between cockpit and cabin.

Various locations: Coronavirus – skydiving is a contact sport - By skydiving and being at skydive city, you assume the risk of covid-19 infection. You are not be safe from coronavirus infection here. No amount of care or caution can assure your protection. We have taken reasonable precautions to protect your health but make no guarantees or representations. You must take your own precautions. If you cannot accept that risk, don't skydive or be at Skydive

City. As a condition of being here: you agree you are not ill and have not been knowingly exposed to covid-19

Signs on manifest doors: Only staff inside manifest office. Do not stick face into manifest window.

Water fountains: Signs/tape to prevent use.

Signs in bathroom stalls: avoid touching surfaces. Use paper towel, gloves or other barrier between your hand and faucets and flush levers.

Sign on Moby Deck: no spectators at skydive city unless you are *accompanied* by a tandem or experienced skydiver.
